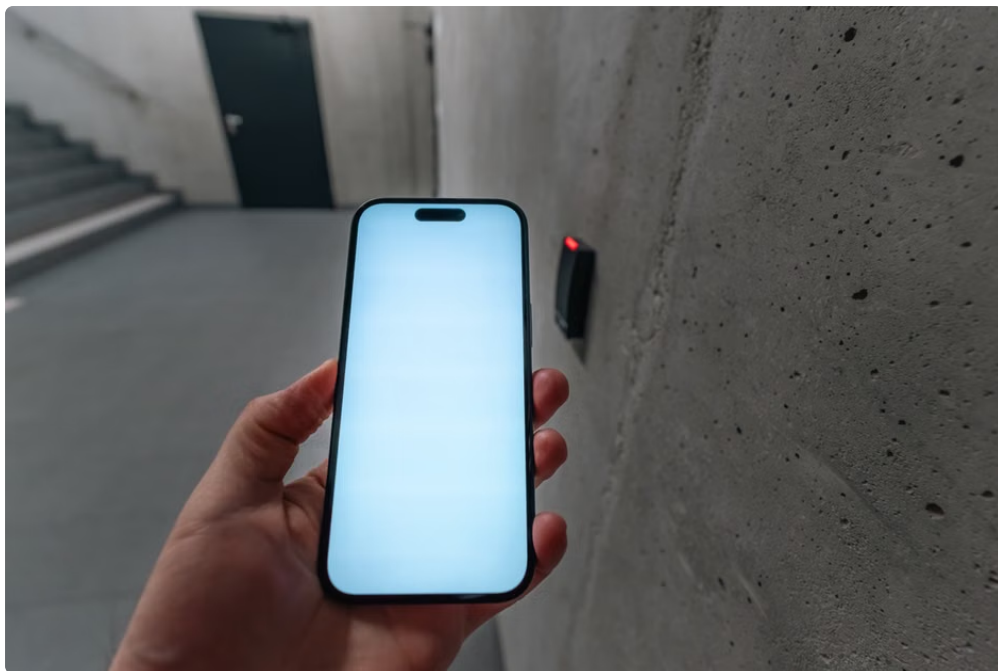

- **Check for HTTPS and SSL certificate:** The official BingoPlus app center URL will use HTTPS, and your browser will show a lock symbol—click it to verify certificate details.
