Like all live music acts, technical requirements matter. Ensure the agency knows the venue size. Ask if the percussionist uses solely acoustic projection. The bongo is a naturally loud instrument, but for large events, it might need to be mic'd. As a client, it's worth discussing whether the player will bring their own gear or if it will be provided by the venue.

Engaging the Crowd

One of the most impactful things a bongo player can do is invite audience participation. Ask your agency if the performer is comfortable engaging with guests and encouraging them to join in [citation:2].
