Go early or late, scheduling the party from the morning hours or late afternoon to avoid the most intense UV rays and heat between noon and three PM. Reserve a shaded pavilion or covered area at a local park or community center well in advance to provide guaranteed, dedicated cover for food, cake, and parents.

Set up a hydration station with plenty of cold drinks, including bottled water, fruit-infused water, and lemonade, keeping them in deep coolers with ice. Event planners recommend always keeping plenty of cool beverages at the ready, freezing bottles of water in advance, and making sure juice boxes and water are easily accessible, especially for little hands.

In hot weather, the best outdoor parties involve water activities that make the activity itself the main way to beat the heat. An at-home water extravaganza with a large inflatable water slide or sprinklers and water tables is a surefire hit, especially for children aged five to twelve. Hiring a mobile foam cannon service creates a unique,

bubbly, and clean-up-friendly activity in your yard. Many community parks also have large, free splash pads where you can reserve a nearby pavilion and let the kids enjoy the water.
