A single day of equipment deployment—one dehumidifier, two air movers, and technician time—costs approximately \$300–\$500. Larger or more severe jobs demand multiple dehumidifiers, specialized low-grain refrigerant dehumidifiers for humid climates, and extended rental periods. Initial moisture assessment and documentation might require 2–4 hours at the lower end of that range; extraction and setup of drying equipment typically runs 3–6 hours at the mid range; and structural repairs, mold remediation, or carpentry work command the higher hourly rates. A low-tier water removal job (extraction only, no structural damage) might involve 8–10 technician hours, totaling \$400–\$1,500 in labor. Mid-tier restorations commonly

require 20–40 hours across multiple days, resulting in \$1,000–\$6,000 in labor costs. High-tier jobs with structural involvement can exceed 50 hours and push labor alone to \$7,500–\$15,000.
