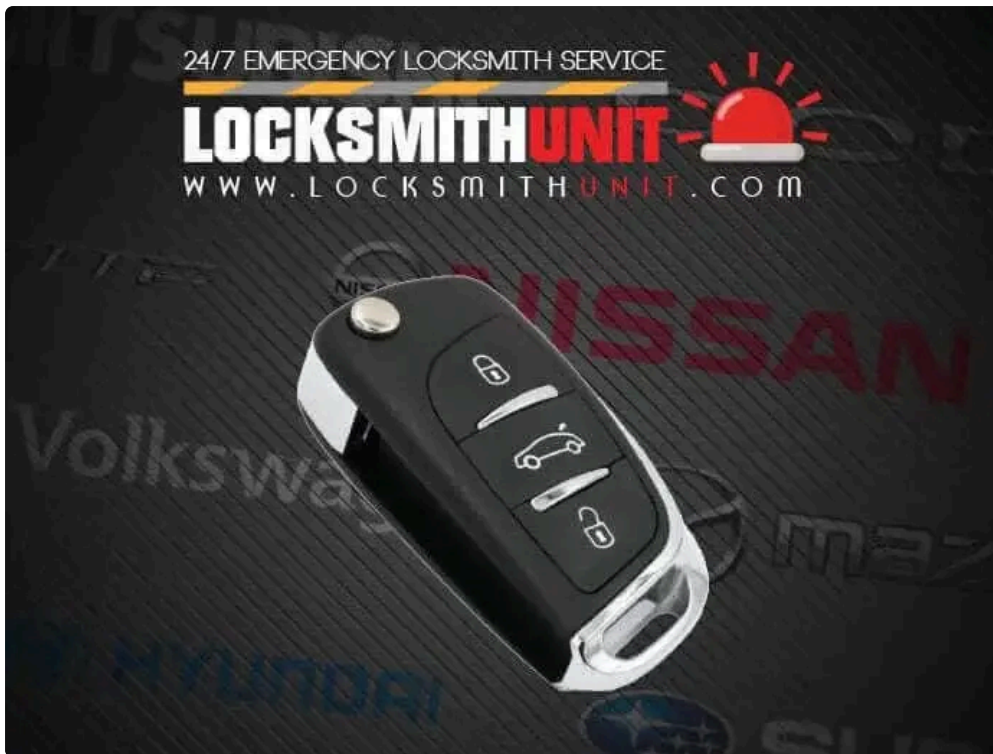

Why office security starts with the right service model
