In the future *Matts*, whose structure still stood, began to expand the event wall surface up to support a flooring that *Matts* was adding to his building. When *Matts* started to rebuild it, Hawkins tore it down once again, and *Matts* filed a claim against Hawkins for trespass. An event wall is a shared framework that separates two adjacent buildings, such as homes or townhouses. 1. A Party Wall Notice to issue to your neighbour(s) which should be given at least two months before work commences.
2. A letter for them to issue in reply if they are happy for you to go ahead.
3. A letter for them to issue in reply if under dispute.

The square brackets instruct you on where to enter your details and those of your neighbours. You can then print out the filled in letters, leaving the lined sections blank for replies. Don't forget to include your signature at the end.

You are required to describe the proposed works, but you can also attach plans of the build if you think they will be helpful. You must attach drawings of the foundations if special foundations are required.

It is intended to commence works after two months or earlier by agreement.

Under section 5, if you do not consent to the works within 14 days you are deemed to have dissented and a dispute is deemed to have arisen. In such case section 10 of the Act requires that both parties should concur in the appointment of a surveyor or should each appoint one surveyor.
