

A faulty garage door can compromise safety, convenience, and entry to your home. Whether your garage door fails to open, the door is making unusual noises, or a broken garage door spring has left the system unsafe, a timely inspection can help avoid additional damage. Inspect the track visually for an obstruction or severe bend, but avoid forcing the door. A door that binds in the track may have worn rollers, damaged hinges, or a cable problem. If the opener hums, strains, or repeatedly stops, continued use can harm the motor and lifting mechanism.

Why Is the Garage Door Noisy, Crooked, or Off Track?

A noisy garage door may have dry hinges, worn garage door rollers, loose fasteners, or a failing spring. Normal operation should produce some sound, but grinding, scraping, popping, or sharp snapping noises require attention. Lubricating appropriate moving parts can help, but lubricant will not correct a broken spring, bent garage door track, or damaged bearing.

A misaligned door often suggests inconsistent cable tension, a failed garage door cable, a damaged roller, or a spring problem. A torsion spring positioned above the door may be broken if there is a noticeable gap in the coil or if the door suddenly feels exceptionally heavy. An extension spring system, which runs along horizontal tracks, can also fail and may have separated or dropped hardware.

A garage door off track is a safety concern. The door can collapse, get stuck, or place excessive tension on cables and rollers. Keep people and vehicles away from the opening and arrange professional service rather than attempting to push the door back into position.

A professional, licensed and insured technician should present the options without pressuring you into replacement. They should also perform a final balance test, safety reversal test, photo-eye test, and inspection of the cables, rollers, springs, track, and opener.

A few low-hazard tasks are safe for homeowners, including replacing remote batteries, cleaning photo-eye sensors, securing accessible non-tension hardware, and monitoring unusual sounds.
