After cleaning with distilled water, the root was sectioned, and their crowns were embedded in high-fusion impression compound, enabling the buccal enamel surface area to be exposed. Requirement enamel-dentin discs 6 centimeters in diameter and 4 cm in density were reduced from the buccal enamel surface area utilizing a water-cooled trephine drill. The discs were wet-polished with 600 and 1200 grit silicon carbide documents. After polishing, enamel was etched using 37% phosphoric acid (Total-etch; Ivoclar-Vivadent, Amherst, NY, United States) for 60 seconds and rinsed with water for 30 seconds³. Then, the prepared specimens were stored in a coffee solution for 1 week at 37 ° C.
