3. Pachinko

- **Frequency:** 2 sectors on the wheel.
- **How it works:** Inspired by the standard Japanese arcade video game, gamers are led to a giant Pachinko wall filled with pegs. The host drops a puck from the top, and it bounces randomly down the board until it lands in one of numerous multiplier slots at the bottom. If the puck arrive on a "DOUBLE" slot, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** 1 segment on the wheel.
- **How it works:** This is the ultimate bonus round. The host opens a red door leading into a surreal, virtual world including a huge virtual wheel with 64 sections and three flappers (Green, Blue, and Yellow). Gamers pick their preferred flapper. The wheel is spun, and whichever multiplier the selected flapper points to is awarded. Simply like Pachinko, hitting a "DOUBLE" or "TRIPLE" triggers the wheel to spin once again with significantly increased multipliers, topping out at an incredible **20,000 x**.
