- **Purchase Cases Directly:** If a specific skin is desired, it is often cheaper to buy it directly from the Steam Community Market or a third-party marketplace rather than attempting to unbox it.
- **Think About Upgrading to CS2-Optimized Skins:** With the engine upgrade to Source 2, metallic finishes, pearls, and dopplers look extraordinary. Cases that drop these finishes have actually seen a surge in visual appeal.
