Significant mismatches between a Google Business Profile and other listed addresses can raise flags within Google's verification systems.

Updating supporting documentation, such as business licenses or utility bills tied to the new address, before making the change in Google Business Profile also helps ensure a smoother verification process if Google requests confirmation of the update.
