Comprehending the Wheel Segments and Betting Options

The 54-segment wheel is divided into numbers and benefit symbols. Gamers can bank on any combination of these sectors during the wagering time window.

The board features 4 numerical bets (1, 2, 5, and 10) and four distinct benefit signs. Here is the breakdown of what is discovered on the wheel:

- **Number 1:** Appears 21 times (Pays 1:1, RTP: 96.08%)

- **Cash Hunt Bonus:** Appears 2 times (RTP: 95.27%)
- **Pachinko Bonus:** Appears 2 times (RTP: 94.33%)

- **Crazy Time Bonus:** Appears 1 time (RTP: 94.41%)

The Top Slot: Amplifying Every Spin

Before every spin of the primary wheel, a two-reel **Top Slot** spins all at once above the game area.

- **Reel 1** displays a bet spot (either a number or a benefit round).
- **Reel 2** screens a multiplier (varying from 2x up to 50x).

If the bet area and the multiplier align horizontally in the Top Slot, a multiplier is applied to that particular outcome for the upcoming spin. - **The Action:** The video game host drops a radiant puck from the top of the board. As the puck bounces arbitrarily down through the pegs, it eventually settles into among the bottom multiplier zones. If the puck

lands on a "DOUBLE" zone, all the bottom multipliers double, and the host drops the puck once again for even bigger wins.

4. Crazy Time

The holy grail of the video game. Hitting this single sector on the wheel carries the gamer behind a red door into a surreal, whimsical virtual world.

- **The Setup:** Behind the door lies a colossal virtual wheel including 64 sectors loaded with massive multipliers and "DOUBLE" or "TRIPLE" sectors. Three flappers (Green, Blue, and Yellow) sit at the top of the wheel.
- **The Action:** The player selects among the 3 flappers before the wheel spins. When the wheel stops, the gamer wins the multiplier suggested by their picked flapper. If it lands on a "DOUBLE" or "TRIPLE," the wheel spins again, and all multipliers on the board are increased accordingly, up to a maximum cap of 20,000 x.
