Stucco and masonry would like breathability. Hard troweled stucco wants etching or a masonry conditioner for correct tooth. Metal surfaces, from railings to business doors, demand rust manage. We remove scale to bare bright steel in which viable, feather intact coatings, solvent wipe to take away oils, and use a rust changing primer on pitted parts.
