2. How to Vet Candidates

Word-of-mouth is the best filter. For their events. They often have a list of preferred vendors. Search online directories. You can see their style and recent work. With samples of their work. A single bad review isn't a dealbreaker, but a trend is. Have they photographed events like yours?. Ask about their experience, professionalism, and reliability. Narrow your list to 3–5 candidates. Move on to the next one. The right photographer will be excited about your party



3. What to Cover in Your Consultation

You want to cover all the important details. Have they worked at venues like yours?. Ask about their style. Do they have backup cameras and lenses?. Do they provide a sneak peek?. Do they have packages?. How far will they travel?. What happens if they get sick?. Ask about their contract. This gives you a sense of their style and quality. Are they friendly and unobtrusive?. If they're evasive, that's a red flag

4. Pricing and Budgeting

Depending on their experience, location, and the length of the event. Expect to pay \$100–\$200 per hour. For [birthday party event planner](#) [birthday planner malaysia](#) [birthday party planner kl](#) a 4-hour event, that's \$800–\$1,600. For a celebrity or highly sought-after photographer. For videography, expect to pay similar rates. Others charge per hour. Like travel fees, parking, and editing fees. The balance is due on the day of the event. You may want the photographer to stay longer. Consider the value. And prevent you from falling in love with something you can't afford. A good photographer is worth the investment

5. Protecting Yourself

It's time to sign the contract. Make sure the contract includes the date, time, and location. It should specify the fee. It should outline what's included. What happens if they cancel?. It protects both parties. It should include the photographer's dress code. A professional photographer will have one. This is optional. Read the contract carefully. And share it with your venue. A well-written contract prevents misunderstandings



6. Must-Have Photos and Videos

These are often the best photos. Include details. For videography. In advance. That you might not have thought of. You want photos with. Let the photographer know. You've hired a professional

After the event, the photographer will edit the photos and videos. Ask about the turnaround time. Within a few days. To make the photos look their best. For videography, the editing process. Like a gallery link or a USB drive. You may also have the option. Review the photos and videos. But major changes may incur an additional fee. And share them with guests. So treasure them forever
