

The DMV region experiences a full range of weather throughout the year, from humid summer afternoons to icy winter mornings, and each condition requires a different approach to protecting belongings during a move. **DMV Movers** plan around these seasonal challenges to keep furniture, boxes, and floors safe regardless of the forecast.

Handling Rainy Moving Days

Rain creates slippery walkways and increases the risk of water damage to boxes and furniture during loading. A DMV Moving Company typically uses plastic wrap on upholstered furniture and mattresses, along with waterproof covers over open truck ramps, [DMV movers](#) to keep moisture away from belongings during transport between the home and the truck.

Floor runners become especially important on rainy days, since wet shoes carried in and out of the home can quickly track water onto hardwood or carpet. Movers in DMV know to lay these protective coverings before the first box comes through the door.

Managing Snow and Ice Safely

Winter moves require extra attention to safety, since [Website link](#) ice on driveways and walkways increases the risk of slips while carrying heavy items. A DMV Moving Company often applies ice melt or sand to walkways before loading begins, and takes extra care with ramps and stairs that may be slick even without visible ice.

Protecting Belongings from Summer Heat

High summer temperatures can affect certain items differently than rain or snow, particularly electronics, candles, and anything with adhesive components that may soften or warp inside a hot truck. DMV Movers plan loading order carefully during summer months, keeping heat-sensitive items accessible for quicker unloading rather than sitting in a parked truck for an extended period.

- Use plastic wrap and waterproof covers during rainy moves
- Apply ice melt or sand to walkways before winter loading
- Prioritize heat-sensitive items for quicker unloading in summer
- Lay floor runners immediately to protect against tracked moisture
