

The call was available in on a windy March morning from a center manager on the Southwest Side. Their neighborhood AHJ had flagged a passage opening throughout a regular evaluation. The old fire door would certainly not drop, the fusible link had actually been painted to the point of uselessness, and the clearance was tight. They required a solution that pleased code, fit the room, tied right into their alarm system, and did not delay procedures for a week. ## **Field installation overview**

- Execute the first decrease examination, document descent rate and complete closure, then reset and seal the tag per NFPA 80 procedures.

A tech with experience will switch over to the right supports, change the embedment, and validate pull-out toughness, instead of thoughtlessly hammering wedge supports into a dental caries. When the slab slopes toward a dock drain, the sill might need a built-up threshold so the bottom bar seals evenly. The current FireKing bottom bars have sufficient adjustability to dial in a consistent touch, but uneven concrete still asks for thoughtful prep.

## **Motorized versus manual, and just how fire release alters the equation**

In day-to-day use, many facilities choose a mechanized rolling door for comfort and rate control, especially on larger openings. 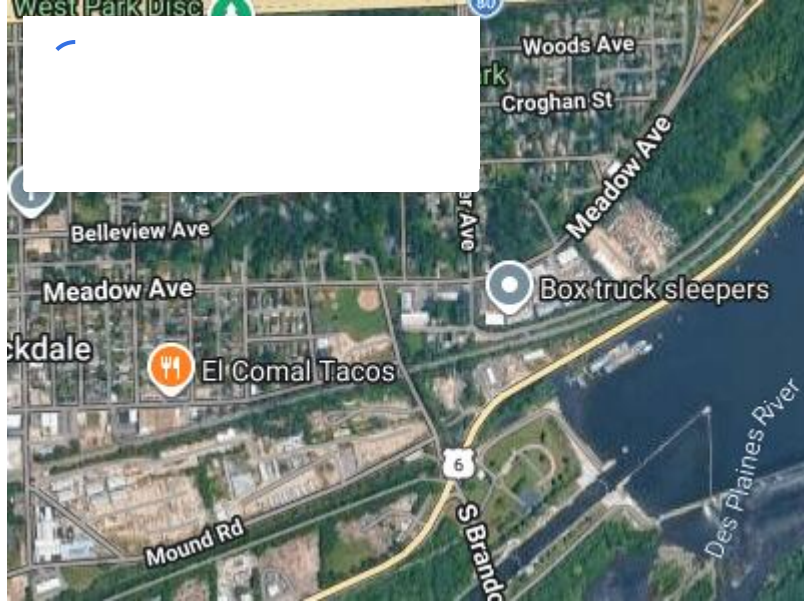
