On a part-acre residential lot simply south of Gretna Crossing Park, the normal equipment had sprays watering a sloped front yard of clay-loam. We switched over the steepest 1/3 to rotors and programmed two brief cycles. Runoff into the road dropped instant, and the owner of a house noticed their invoice fall about 18 % in July when compared to the previous 12 months.

A church campus close to the Holy Family Shrine had formal beds that struggled in wind. Switching to dripline lower than mulch and including wind skip to the controller cut leaf spot in part the following season.

How irrigation integrates with mowing, cleanup, and construction

When we organize either irrigation companies and weekly lawn care, timing prevents a variety of small concerns. Crews mowing medians on Highway 6 do now not favor rainy turf at 7 a.m. Tuesdays, and home owners do not wish wheel ruts.
