Players take control of an on-screen crosshair and choose a sign before a countdown timer ends. When time runs out, all signs reveal their concealed multipliers.

3. Pachinko

- **Frequency:** 2 segments on the wheel.
- **How it works:** Inspired by the traditional Japanese arcade video game, gamers are resulted in a huge Pachinko wall filled with pegs. The host drops a puck from the top, and it bounces randomly down the board until it lands in among numerous multiplier slots at the bottom. If the puck arrive on a "DOUBLE" slot, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** 1 section on the wheel.
- **How it works:** This is the ultimate reward round. The host opens a red door leading into a surreal, virtual world including a huge virtual wheel with 64 segments and three flappers (Green, Blue, and Yellow). Players pick their preferred flapper. The wheel is spun, and whichever multiplier the chosen flapper points to is awarded. Similar to Pachinko, striking a "DOUBLE" or "TRIPLE" causes the wheel to spin again with vastly increased multipliers, capping out at a shocking **20,000 x**.
