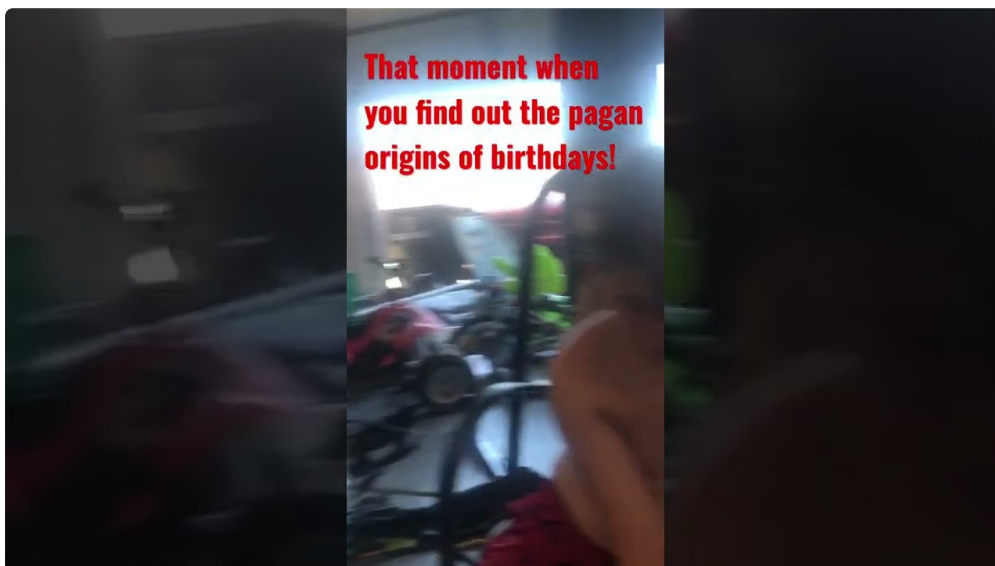
Including Family and Friends Back Home

Deciding where to celebrate for an expat's birthday in Malaysia is about balancing the familiar with the new .

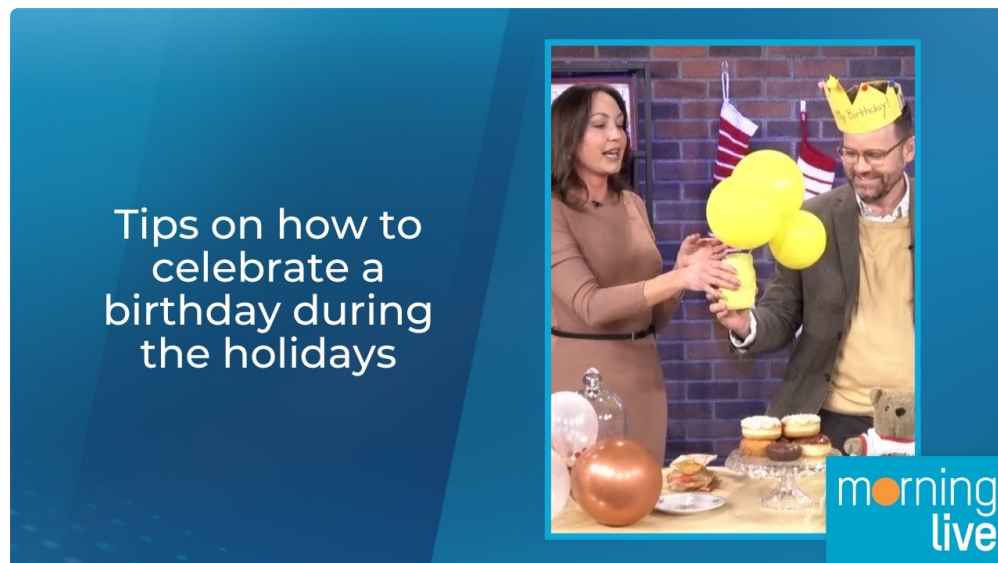
You might choose a fusion venue that's both familiar and new. There are international restaurants in major Malaysian cities . Consider reading reviews online .
