Using Short-Form Video (Instagram Reels) to Show Fit and Movement

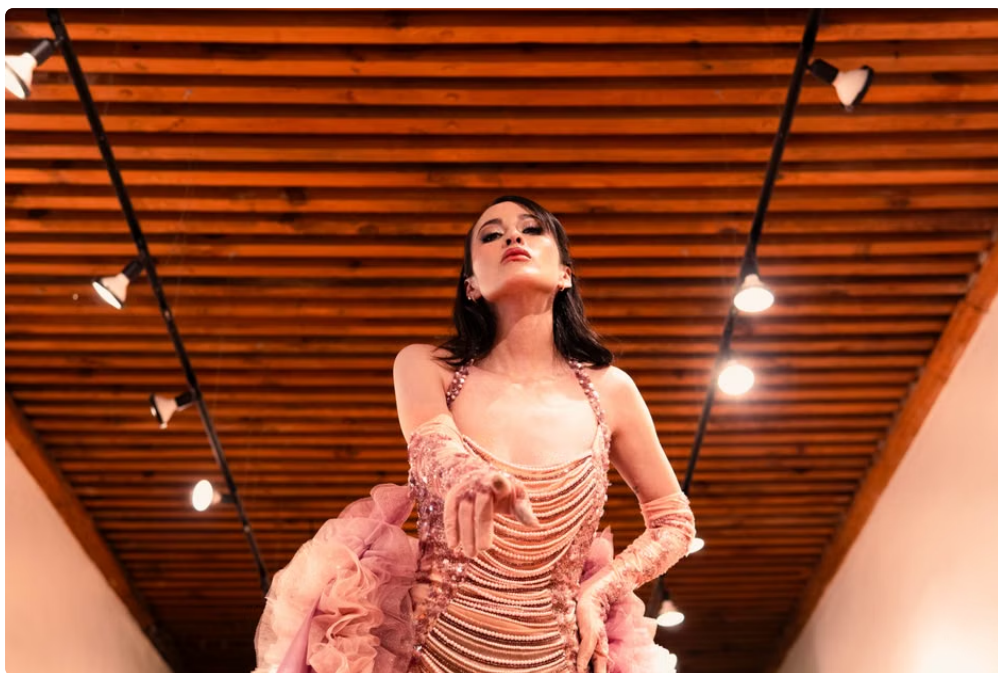
Static images sometimes fail to communicate the true flow and fit of casual wear, especially fabrics that drape or stretch. This is where Reels shine.
