Two summers later, the island seems like day one. The granite lower back run exhibits pretty much no difference, and the soapstone has deepened in colour where fingers naturally contact it. No one concerns about a lemon wedge at the island, and the grill section wipes fresh after Friday fish nights. The preference wasn't theoretical. Care habits that make the difference
