Android vs iPhone/iPad Installation Routes: What Differs?

Android Installation Steps

1. Visit app.bingoplus.com on your Android phone or tablet.

3. If sideloading via APK, Android will prompt you to allow installation from unknown sources. Stay cautious and double-check the URL again before approving.

iPhone/iPad Installation Steps

1. Open Safari or your preferred browser and visit app.bingoplus.com.
2. Tap the link to the App Store to download BingoPlus officially.
3. Complete the installation through the App Store. iOS manages permissions automatically; you won't be asked explicitly for network access permission.
4. Open the app and securely log in to BingoPlus.
5. If you face connectivity issues, toggle network settings or restart your device to reset connections.

Remember: iOS App Store apps won't ask for network permission explicitly because Apple's security model grants it automatically to installed apps. So, if you see network permission requests like on Android, question if the app is genuine.
