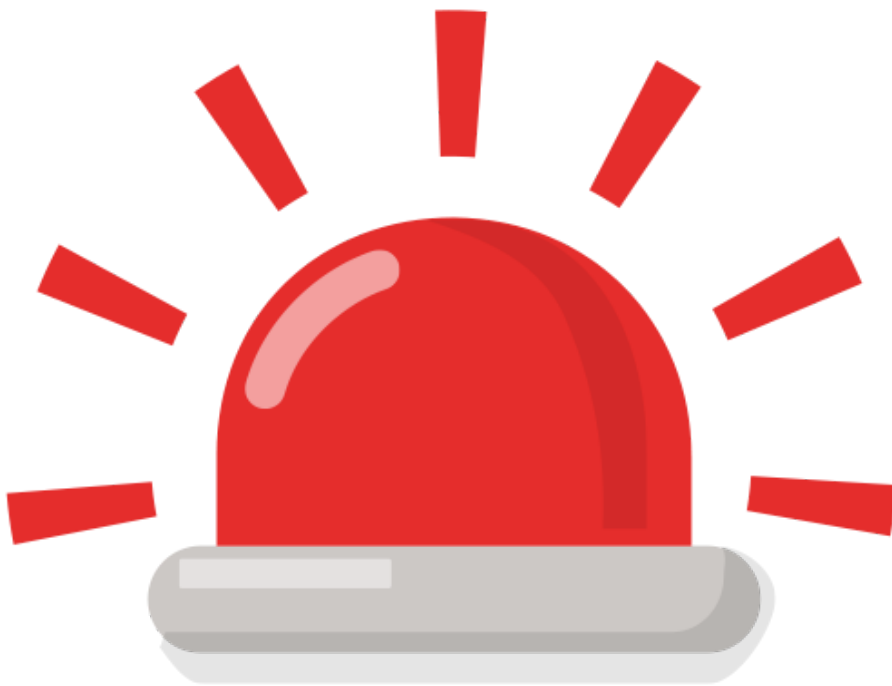
What Florida law adds to the picture
