

Soft Tissue and Whiplash Injury Claims in Midland TX A rear-end tap at a Loop 250 stoplight can look like nothing at the scene. Both drivers step out, glance at the bumpers, trade insurance cards and head home. Then, a day or two later, the neck stiffens, a headache settles behind the eyes and turning to check a blind spot becomes a chore. That delayed pattern is typical of whiplash and other soft tissue injuries, and it's one reason these claims are so often challenged. Here's what happens in the body. When a vehicle is struck from behind, the head snaps backward and then forward faster than the neck muscles can brace. Ligaments, tendons and muscles can stretch or tear. Those injuries rarely show up on a standard X-ray, which is exactly why insurance companies like to downplay them. An adjuster may point to minor property damage, argue that you waited too long to see a doctor or suggest the pain came from something else. Stop-and-go traffic on Loop 250 north, around Big Spring Street and along Andrews Highway produces plenty of these low-speed collisions, and plenty of these arguments.

The answer is documentation, starting early. Get checked at Midland Memorial Hospital, an urgent care or your own doctor as soon as symptoms appear, and say plainly where it hurts and when it started. Follow the treatment plan, whether that's physical therapy, medication or imaging, and try not to leave gaps between visits. Save photos of both vehicles, even if the damage [Midland Car Accident Lawyer](#) looks small. Request the Texas Peace Officer's Crash Report, form CR-3, through TxDOT's Crash Records Information System if police responded. Each of these steps makes it harder for an insurer to call your injury exaggerated. The Doan Law Firm handles these cases the same way it handles larger ones. Texas generally allows two years to file a personal injury lawsuit, though evidence is easier to gather sooner. If you were hurt, missed work or the other driver's insurer is disputing fault, a lawyer usually pays for themselves. Most car accident lawyers work on contingency, meaning the fee is a percentage of what they recover and nothing if they lose. The exact percentage is set out in writing in your fee agreement before any work begins. How much of a \$25,000 settlement will I actually receive? Texas gives you two years from the crash to file most injury lawsuits, but waiting that long is risky. Anything you say in a recorded statement can be used to argue you share the blame, which matters under Texas rules that cut your recovery by your percentage of fault.
