

Salt Lakes

Las Salinas de Torrevieja has plenty of areas to take pleasure in outside events of any type of size. This spectacular natural wonder is among the highlights of the Costa Blanca and an impressive view to see with your own eyes. Then, in 1988, it was declared a natural park by the Valencian Federal government in order to shield it, till it obtained definitive protection in 1996. Since the 15th century, the La Mata lagoon has been just one of the major centres in the Mediterranean both for gathering and exporting salt. Nonetheless, after nearly a century of analysis, the high salinity put an end to the task. Presently, it appreciates over 3.000 hours of sunshine each year, with warm summer seasons and moderate winter seasons.

The history of Torrevieja would certainly not be complete without its famous "salinas" (salt lakes). Cala Ferris offers one of one of the most amazing surroundings in Torrevieja-- a small coastline of fine gold sand backed by sand dunes and masses of palm trees, and crystal clear sea. Los Náufragos beach is separated from Playa del Acequión by a salt dock (used to keep salt from the salt lakes and to fill vendor ships). Stroll a number of streets back from the seafront to see the historical Plaza de la Constitución, where you'll find the City center and the spectacular Inmaculada Concepción Church (1789). Playa del Cura is located in the heart of Torrevieja and the most preferred beach in town. The lively seafront has numerous memento stores, dining establishments, ice-cream parlours and clubs, and the distinctive Mediterranean Cultures Monument. Cala Palangre is the tiny cove surrounded by rocks found at the end of Playa de Los Locos.

Similar Tasks In Laguna De Torrevieja

It is believed that the Salinas de Torrevieja were currently being collected as much back in the 14th century. They include an immense natural location of over 3.700 hectares situated approximately Alicante known as the Vega Baja del Segura.
