Because enclosed carriers generally provide a more specialized service and have limited capacity, the cost may be higher than open transport. The best choice depends on your vehicle's value, condition, and protection requirements.

- Special equipment requirements

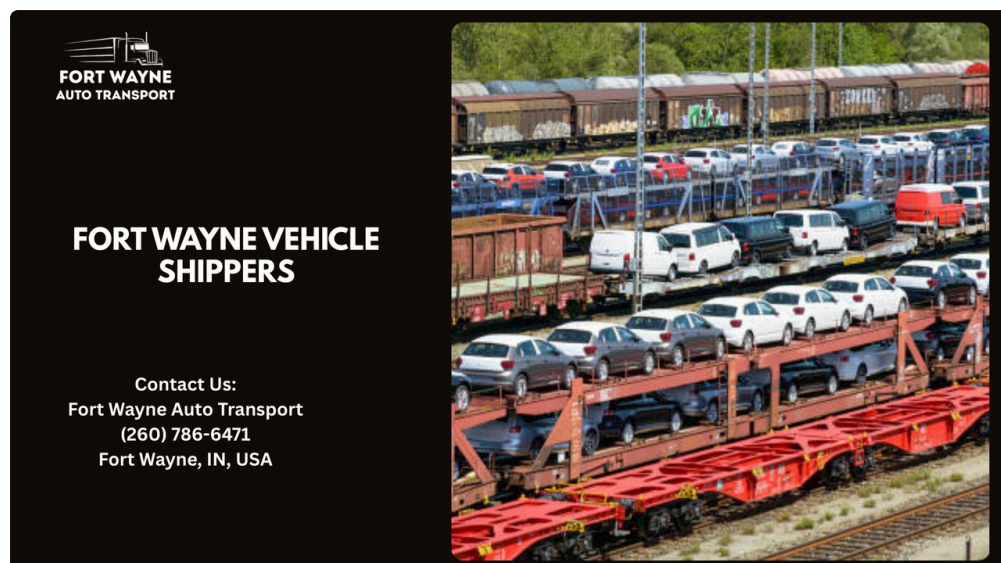

Preparing Your Vehicle for Transport

Proper preparation can help make the shipping process smoother. Start by cleaning the exterior of your vehicle. A clean surface makes it easier to identify existing scratches, dents, or other damage during the inspection.

Remove personal belongings and unnecessary items from the interior and trunk. Loose objects can move around during transportation and may cause damage. Many carriers also have restrictions regarding personal items, so confirm the company's policy before loading anything inside the vehicle.

Check your vehicle's fluids, tire pressure, battery, and fuel level. If the car is operational, it should generally have enough fuel for loading and unloading without carrying an unnecessarily full tank.

Disable alarms and secure removable accessories when appropriate. If your vehicle has special features or operating instructions, provide those details to the carrier.

Document Existing Vehicle Damage

Before the vehicle is picked up, inspect it carefully. Take clear photographs from multiple angles and document any existing scratches, dents, chips, or other visible damage.

The carrier will typically conduct a condition inspection before loading the vehicle. Review the inspection report carefully and make sure it accurately reflects the vehicle's condition. Keep your photographs and shipping documents until the vehicle has been delivered and inspected again.

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Understanding Pickup and Delivery Times

Auto transport is different from parcel delivery. A vehicle may travel through several cities before reaching its final destination, and carriers must coordinate multiple pickups and deliveries along their route.

Weather, traffic, road construction, mechanical problems, and other circumstances can affect transportation schedules. For this reason, professional **Fort Wayne car shippers** may provide estimated pickup and delivery windows rather than guaranteeing an exact arrival time.

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If you have a strict deadline, discuss it before booking. If your schedule is flexible, you may have more transportation options and potentially better pricing.

Door-to-Door vs. Terminal Shipping

Door-to-door service is designed to provide pickup and delivery as close as practical to your requested addresses. However, large transport trucks may not be able to access every residential street because of narrow roads, low branches, weight restrictions, or local regulations.

In such situations, the carrier may arrange a nearby meeting location that is safer and easier for loading and unloading. Terminal-based transportation may also be available in certain markets.

Questions to Ask Before Hiring a Transport Company

Before signing a contract, ask important questions about the shipment. Consider asking:

- Are you a broker, carrier, or both?
- What type of carrier will transport my vehicle?
- What insurance coverage is provided?
- What is included in the quoted price?
