What is Crazy Time?

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Understanding the Wheel Segments and Bets

Players have 8 various wagering choices on the table. These are split in between basic number bets (1, 2, 5, and 10) and the four bonus offer video game sectors. Each number corresponds to the number of times it appears on the wheel.

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As seen in the table above, the numbers appear far more regularly than the bonus offer rounds, making them safer bets with smaller payouts, while the reward rounds are rarer but use life-altering payout capacities.

The Heart of the Action: The Four Bonus Rounds

The main attraction of Crazy Time is certainly its four interactive perk mini-games. Activating one of these rounds carries players from the main studio into a dazzling, immersive augmented-reality world.

1. Coin Flip

The easiest of the four reward rounds. A coin with a red side and a blue side is flipped [Article source](#) by a mechanical flipper.

- Before the flip, random multipliers are designated to both the red and blue sides.
- Whichever side lands deal with up wins the multiplier for the gamers who bank on Coin Flip.
- If the multipliers are low, a "Rescue Flip" can often be activated, giving gamers another possibility at higher benefits.

2. Cash Hunt

This is a giant shooting gallery screen featuring 108 random multipliers concealed behind numerous symbols (such as a cactus, a target, a chef's hat, etc).

- Gamers are given a restricted time to aim and fire a cannon at a sign of their option.
- As soon as time ends, the cannon fires, exposing the multiplier hidden behind the selected icon.
- Because every gamer can select a various spot on the screen, different gamers will win various amounts.

3. Pachinko

Influenced by the traditional Japanese arcade game, the Pachinko benefit round includes a huge physical wall filled with pegs.

- The video game host drops a puck from the top of the wall.
- The puck bounces arbitrarily down through the pegs up until it lands in one of the landing zones at the bottom, each consisting of a multiplier.
- If the puck lands in a zone marked **"DOUBLE,"** all multipliers on the board are doubled, and the puck is dropped again. This can duplicate until the optimum multiplier limit is reached.

4. Crazy Time

The supreme bonus round occurs behind a red door, leading to a gigantic virtual wheel containing 64 sections and three flippers (green, blue, and yellow).

- Players need to choose one of the 3 flippers before the wheel spins.
- The giant wheel features massive multipliers and "DOUBLE" or "TRIPLE" sectors.
- If the wheel stops on a Double or Triple, all multipliers on the wheel are doubled or tripled, and the wheel spins again.
- The optimum possible win in this round is capped at an impressive **20,000 x** the gamer's bet.
