How Transactions Work: Steam API and P2P Trading

Today, the majority of platforms utilize **Peer-to-Peer (P2P) systems**.

2. The depositing player sends out the skin directly to the purchaser via a safe and secure Steam trade link.
3. The site credits the depositor's account balance once the trade is verified.

This approach assists platforms circumvent direct involvement in handling Valve's stock products while keeping the virtual economy streaming.

Threats Associated with CS2 Gambling
