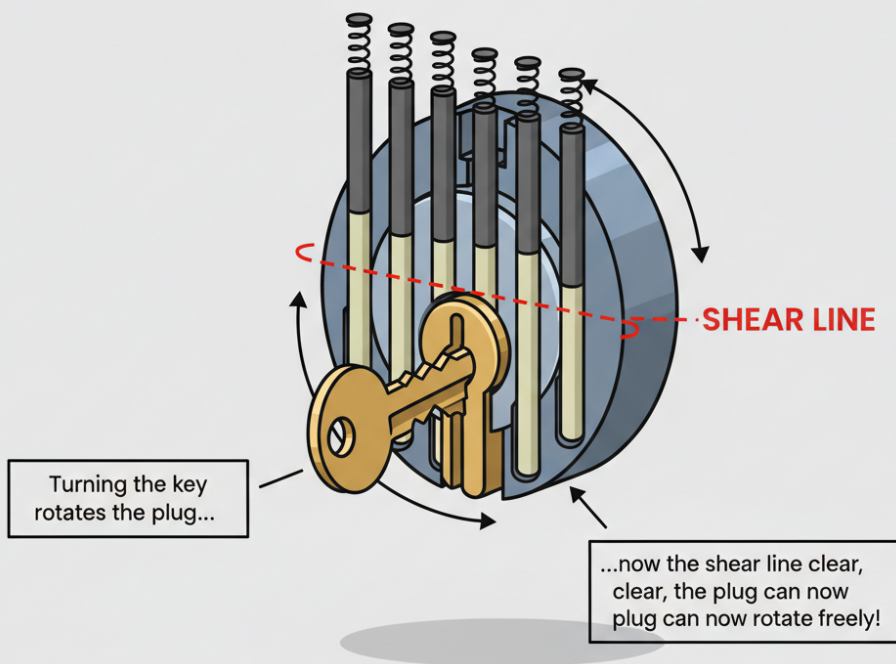
Why access control decisions should stay practical

How lock installation fits with older hardware

What to look for before approving the job
