process. Hardware holes had been crammed and re-drilled to switch from three-inch pulls to five-inch, which required a jig and persistence to preserve lines straight.

From arrival to remaining wipe-down took eight running days. At day 3 after rehang, the finish felt dry however we nonetheless counseled mushy use for a couple of weeks. Six months later the shopper often known as, no longer with a criticism, but to agenda ceiling portray functions in the adjacent circle of relatives room due to the fact that the cabinets made the historical ceiling glance tired.
