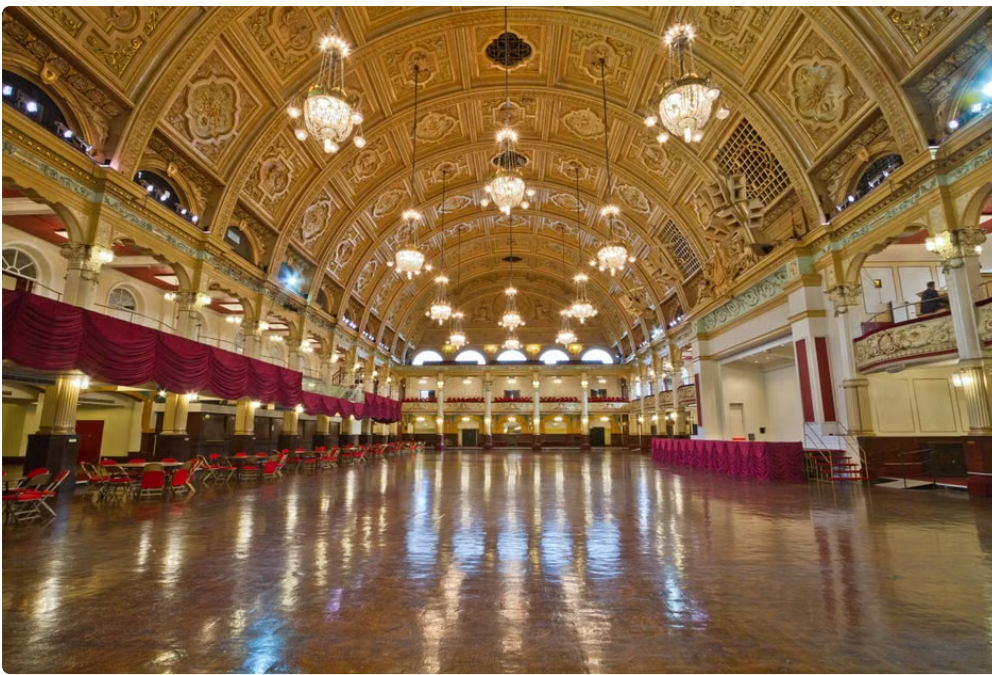
5. Push Notifications and Social Reminders
