- **The Recommendation:** Stick to **1v1 battles** or **2v2 group battles** if consistency is the goal. While 4-player free-for-alls provide enormous payouts, your analytical probability of winning drops to just 25%.

## 3. Examine Case Volatility

Cases have different risk-and-reward profiles. Some cases include constant, low-tier skin drops (steady worth), while others rely heavily on pulling an unusual knife or covert skin to turn an earnings.

- **High-Volatility Cases:** Contain pricey knives and gloves, but the floor drops are worth pennies. These are high-risk, high-reward.
