

One of the most common reasons that beginner violinists in Singapore struggle with the instrument is not a lack of talent or application, but a poorly set-up violin. An instrument with a bridge that is too high, a nut that has not been cut correctly, strings that are too heavy for <https://www.pexels.com/@loretta-porter-2162572798/> the player's level, or a soundpost that is out of position will be significantly harder to play than a well-adjusted instrument. LVL Music Academy's luthier team ensures that every violin leaving the shop is set up to the highest standard. Alan Senejani's expertise in instrument set-up extends beyond simply adjusting the bridge height. He considers the entire instrument as a system, ensuring that the pegs turn smoothly, the tailpiece is positioned correctly, the fine tuners are appropriate for the strings being used, and the bow hair is in good condition.
