

Los Angeles vs. San Diego: Garage Door Service at a Glance

Common Garage Door Problems in Los Angeles

A **broken garage door spring** is one of the most serious problems. Symptoms can include a door that will not lift, a visible gap in a spring, loud snapping sounds, or a door that feels too heavy for the opener. A technician should inspect the entire balance system rather than replacing only the visibly damaged component.
