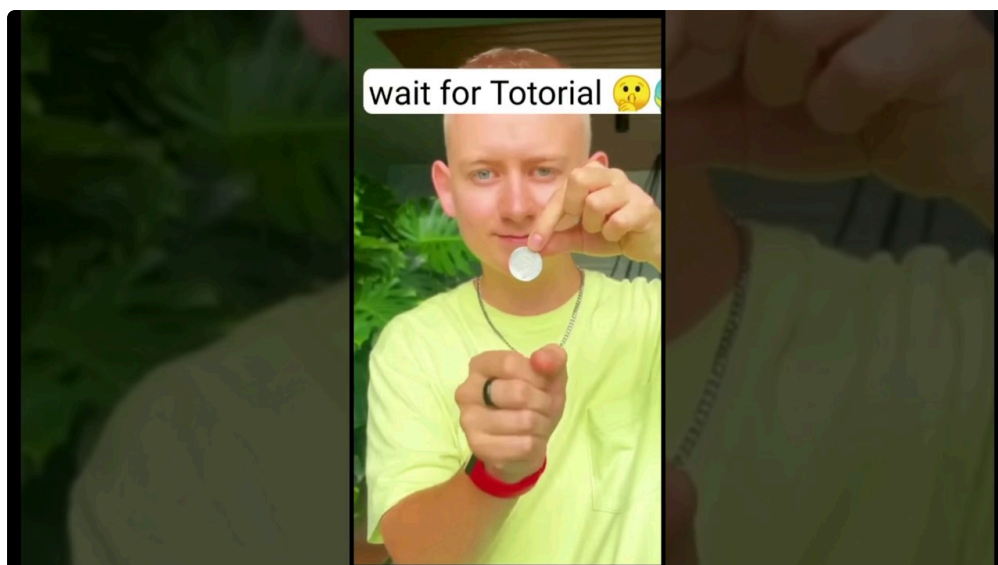
Look for "forgiving" mechanics

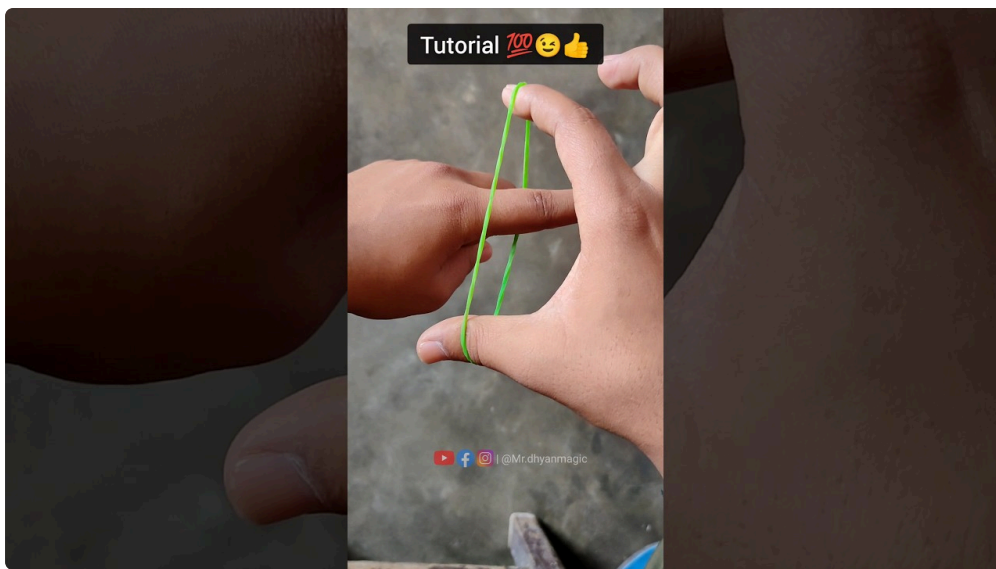
