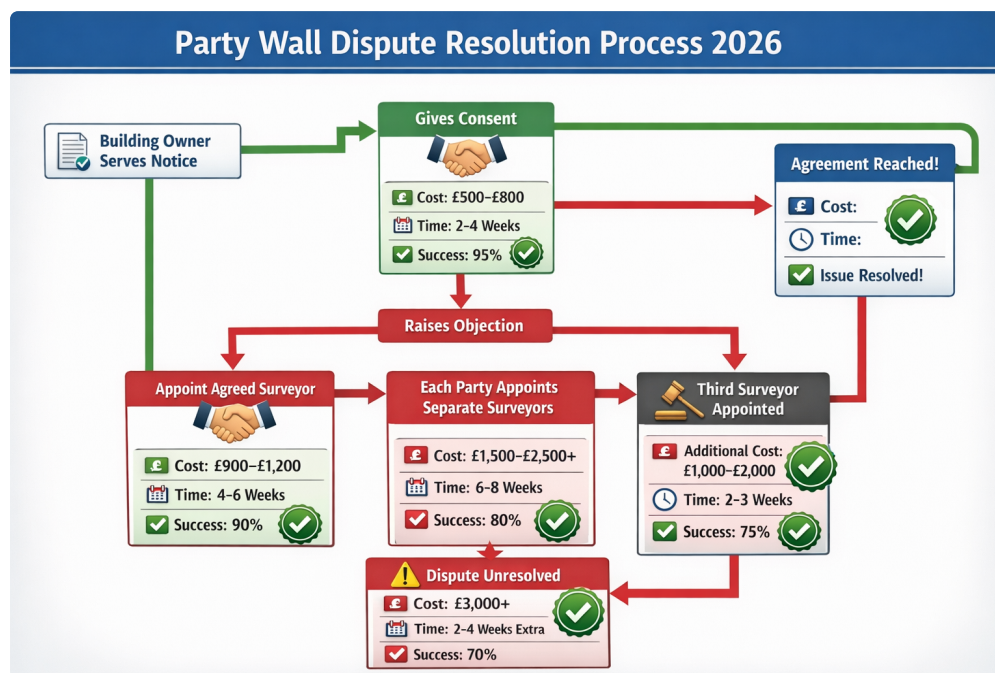
Can my neighbour drill into my fencing post?
