- **API Restrictions:** Changes to Steam's Application Programming Interface (API) have made it harder for automated gambling bots to operate smoothly.

Regardless of these efforts, operators continuously find workaround approaches, using peer-to-peer listing systems or cryptocurrency intermediaries to bypass direct Steam inventory transfers.
