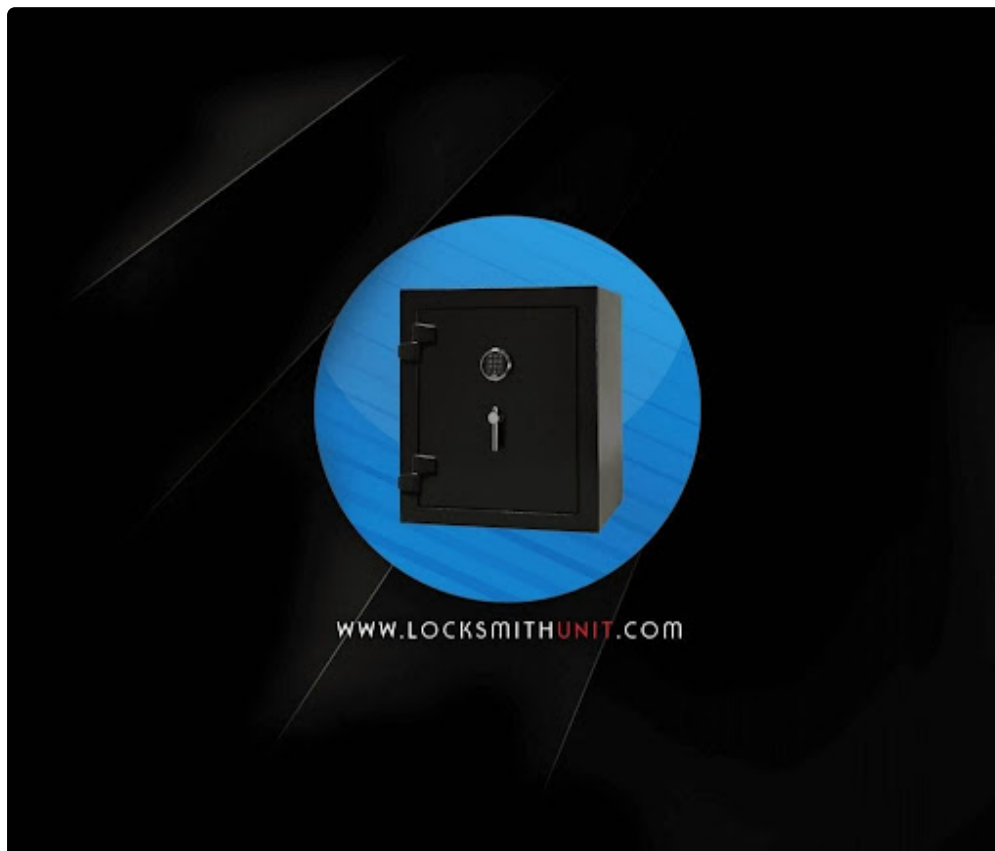
Where keypad hardware makes the most sense
