Cardboard bales accounted for two trucks worth of extent we did now not ought to haul, which minimize disposal rates with the aid of round 20 %. E-waste went to a qualified recycler with a serialized checklist, and we delivered graphic packets to the district supervisor previously 7 a.m. Final walk-throughs with the owner went smoothly. The best time saver became a manager who staged broken item and referred to as out two furniture that had been moving to a nearby region so we did not unintentionally haul them.

Aftercare: finishing clean and final the loop
