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Walk through any Arlington community in April and you see the very same story on a lot of homes: green film creeping up siding, dark stripes on gutters, streaks on the driveway, and brick steps that get slick after a rain. The mix of humidity, tree cover, pollen, and road salt in Northern Virginia is rough on outside surfaces. A great contractor can make a property look 5 years younger in an afternoon. A bad one can etch your brick, scar your deck, or void your roof service warranty simply as fast.

On older brick rowhouses or painted masonry near Lyon Town or Aurora Highlands, a skilled pro will dial the pressure way down and focus on chemistry and dwell time. High pressure on old mortar can speed up collapsing and leave wand marks that become obvious once the wall dries.

Roof washing

Roof cleaning is where the space between specialists and "guy with a machine" becomes stark.

Asphalt shingle roofing systems with black streaks are incredibly common in Arlington. Those streaks are typically a type of algae referred to as *Gloeocapsa magma*. Two points separate cautious specialists from the rest. The very first is how they speak about your manufacturer's warranty. The majority of shingle makers clearly alert versus high pressure on roofing systems. If a specialist suggests blasting the shingles at close range, they are welcoming granular loss and early aging. The second is how they safeguard your residential or commercial property while they work. Roof runoff can stress plants, discolor metals, and leave streaks if not managed. The team must be prepared to tarp or pre-wet vulnerable landscaping and display downspouts.

Tile, metal, and flat roofs each need various approaches. Sometimes, a specialist may actually recommend not cleaning a particular roof area if the threat surpasses the benefit, for instance on really brittle, old shingles over a shallow pitch.
