Preventing Gift Grabbing Before the Party

1. Establish Ground Rules Early

Before the party, talk to your child about what to expect. Kollysphere's specialists advise clarifying that offerings are for the honouree and that attendees will bring their own gifts.

3. Communicate with Other Parents

The most important thing is to keep your composure. Don't raise your voice or shame the kid.
